Canada Child Benefit	There will be a temporary increase to Canada Child Benefit payments by approximately \$300 in May 2020 for each child. This payment will happen automatically and no application is required if you are already receiving this child benefit.		
Canada Student Loans	A six-month, interest-free reprieve on <u>Canada student loan</u> payments. Students will be automatically enrolled into the six-month loan holiday program.		
Goods and Service Tax Credit	There will be a one-time payment by early May 2020 of the Goods and Services Tax credit (GSTC), which will double the maximum annual GSTC payment amounts for the 2019-20 benefit year, for amount of \$400 to \$600 for single person and couple respectively. This payment will happen automatically if you are already receiving this GST tax credit.		
Emergency Care Benefit	weekly, for up to 15 weeks. This flat-payment Benefit would provide income support to: -Workers, including the self-employed, who are quarantined or sick with COVID-19 but do not qualify for El sickness benefits. -Workers, including the self-employed, who are taking care of a family member who is sick with COVID-19, such as an elderly parent, but do not qualify for El sickness benefits. -Parents with children who require care or supervision due to school closures, and are unable to earn employment	Application for the benefit will be available in April 2020, Canadians will need to re-attest every two weeks to reconfirm their eligibility.
