

Programs Committee - May 12, 2021 AGM

With the on going pandemic and the continued restrictions on social gatherings and group activities a number of our programs are still suspended at this time. However, eight programs are currently still allowed to run including the before and after school care (Edusarc) and the pre-school (Kaleidoscope Kids). A detailed list of programs is available at the end to this report.

The Good Food Box (GFB) continues to be a well received and much appreciated program offering by Edgemont and surrounding community residents. Since the launch of the program in 2019 by the late Lois Uptigrove, it has filled over 800 orders of fresh quality produce.

The annual Christmas Hampers Program was once again a huge success. With the generous donations and support of Edgemont residents, local businesses, schools and churches, we were able provide 10 families with a happy Christmas.

Last fall active stencils, from a 24 foot wide circle maze to hopscotch, were borrowed from the City of Calgary Recreation and with the help of 30 volunteers the stencils spray painted in 10 locations around Edgemont for the community to enjoy a free outdoor activity (see picture at the end of this report).
